#### 🌼 Blossom Season Begins in April

Apple, cherry, and peach trees start to bloom across the Okanagan this month. For a scenic drive or a peaceful walk, head to East Kelowna Road, Lake Country, or the Glenmore trails. It's one of the most beautiful times of the year.

- The Property Transfer Tax Exemption Has Increased As of April 1, 2025, newly built homes priced up to \$1.1 million may now qualify for a full exemption from BC's Property Transfer Tax. This update may significantly reduce upfront costs for eligible buyers.
- Spring Is the Time to Check Your Irrigation System
  Before turning it on, inspect for any cracked lines, leaky sprinkler heads, or clogged nozzles. Even a small issue can lead to water waste or unnecessary damage. Many local companies offer quick spring tune-ups to get your system ready for the season.
