With Shorter Days Here

Some simple ways to bring more light and warmth into your home

01 CHOOSE WARMER BULBS

Switching to warm white or amber bulbs creates a softer, more comfortable feel as the days get shorter.

02 USE SMART TIMERS FOR A FEW KEY LIGHTS

Entry lights or one main living-area lamp on a timer help your home feel welcoming the moment you walk in.

03 LEAN ON LAMP LIGHTING INSTEAD OF OVERHEADS

Lamps add a softer glow and create a warmer ambience in the evenings.

04 USE MIRRORS TO HELP MOVE LIGHT THROUGH THE ROOM

Placing a mirror across from a window or lamp can naturally brighten darker areas.

05 ADD MICRO STRING LIGHTS FOR A GENTLE SEASONAL TOUCH

Tucked into a vase or around an artificial plant, they add a soft sparkle that feels a little magical.



NOVEMBER Maintenance Tips

- Sweep away wet leaves along walkways and steps. They get slippery fast this time of year and are easier to clear before frost sets in.
- Check the rubber seals on your exterior doors. Feel for drafts; a quick weatherstrip fix can prevent heat loss all winter.
- Clean your dryer vent housing, not just the lint tray. It takes two minutes and can dramatically improve dryer efficiency.

“Months of Inventory” What it actually means

You may have seen the term “months of inventory” in real estate updates and wondered what it really means. Simply, it measures how long the existing supply of homes would take to sell if no new listings were added.

Fewer than 4 months of inventory generally signals a seller’s market, 4 to 6 months is considered balanced, and anything above that leans toward a buyer’s market. Lower numbers point to a quicker pace; higher numbers mean more selection.

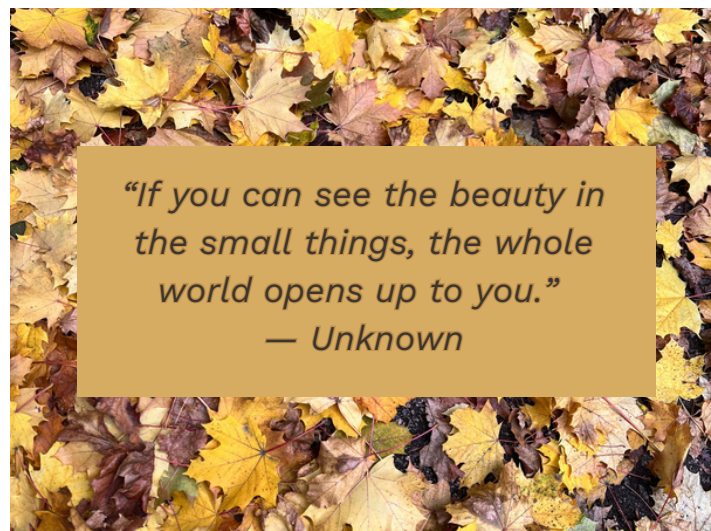
A quick guide:

- Fewer than 4 months of inventory: seller’s market
- 4 to 6 months: balanced market
- More than 6 months: buyer’s market

Market Snapshot October 2025 vs 2024

As the crisp November air settles in and the last of the autumn leaves fall, many of us are shifting our focus indoors, prepping for the holiday season, cozy dinners, and maybe even planning for the year ahead. With Remembrance Day around the corner, it's also a time for reflection and gratitude, for the people and places that make our community so special.

October's real estate market continued to show stability, with activity remaining relatively steady across most property types. **Single-family home sales** came in at **171 for the month**, nearly mirroring last October's 175. The **average sale price** inched up slightly to **just over \$1,024,000**, suggesting that values are holding firm even as buyers take a more measured approach.

Inventory remains healthy, with **8 months of supply for both single-family homes and townhomes**, and **9 months for condos**. This balance means that buyers have room to shop and negotiate, while sellers are still seeing reasonable interest — especially for well-priced, move-in-ready homes. **Residential lots** remain a slower segment, with **28 months of inventory**, reflecting more cautious demand for land and new builds.

Perhaps the biggest news this month is the **Bank of Canada's recent 0.25% rate cut** — the first in some time. This small but significant move has already sparked fresh interest among buyers who had been sitting on the sidelines. Lower borrowing costs could help nudge some activity into late fall and early winter, particularly for well-priced listings.

As we move into the quieter months, the market tends to take a seasonal pause, but this can often be an excellent time for serious buyers and sellers to make their move — with less competition and more opportunity for meaningful negotiation.

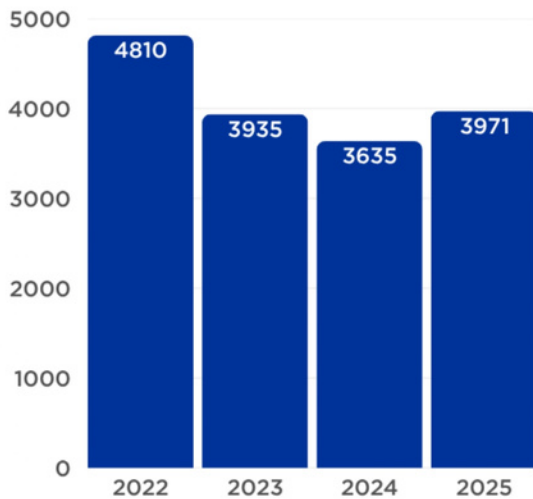
